

A key outcome of the HLF's investment is for visitors and volunteers to have learnt about the cemetery's rich heritage. A visitor centre will provide facilities for visitors and volunteers to learn about, and enjoy, the cemetery's rich heritage and environment. The building design has evolved in consultation with partners and stakeholders. A rear extension will provide a 42-seater talk/lecture/activity space, which will also be hireable for community use. Improvements to the external layout will help to support the new uses of the lodge building. A courtyard will provide a meeting / destination point with information boards and displays, and a new entrance and railings will provide secure 'out of hours' access to the building.
